Why?

On November 19, 2021 the U.S. House of Representatives passed the Build Back Better Plan which includes plans to tackle climate change, anti-poverty programs, health care, and more but falls short when it comes to immigration reform since it does not include a pathway to citizenship for the 11 million undocumented immigrants who have built their lives in this country. This is not a permanent solution but a "band-aid" since it fails to create a pathway to citizenship for the nearly 7.1 million people who could qualify for it. There is still an opportunity for our community to create change and apply pressure to our elected officials to complete what they promised. The fight is still not over!
